- Understand current legislation, construction methods and information exchange processes
- Be an RIBA / ARB member

The role will generally include:

- Undertake peer reviews of the design team's RIBA Stage 3 or 4 information and report thereon
- Review of Contractor's Proposals to check they comply with the Employer's Requirements
- Providing advice and support the Client, EA and PM teams throughout
- Providing independent advice on proposed Client or Contractor design changes

- Monitoring design progress against on-site construction progress
- On-site and off-site inspections of samples, benchmarks and mock-ups and reporting thereon (this may involve occasional travel abroad)
- Attendance at key project meetings (Early Warning, Progress, Main Contractor and Client)
- Inspect of the works and reporting any non-compliances identified
- Using the Contractor's Information Management System (EDMS) to inspect the design documents issued by the contractor, checking they comply with the Contract, Building Regulations, other standards etc. adding relevant comments and applying an Approval Status
- Preparing concise Site Inspection & Monthly Compliance reports for the Client team
- Assisting in the continual review of quality and snagging of the works prior to PC
- Inspecting the works during and at the end of defects period
- Reviewing and commenting on O&Ms prepared by the contractor
- Reviewing spatial layouts and preliminary designs by potential tenants and assessing the impact on the base build works
- Assisting the client team to review extensions of time or late completion claims
